


BHS Values & Mission Statement





K21A K21B

You may apply to one of two programs:

- 1. K21A: International Baccalaureate **AND/OR**
- 2. K21B: Culinary, Career, & College

- Continuing BHS 8th grade students have weighted preference
- On average, 55% 70% of 8th graders continue on into High School
- We will be accepting 120 ninth grade students for September 2022
