- Identifying what is taking place when learning is going well so it can **be reproduced and further developed**
- Creating **better communication** and **transparency** with families.

## SCEP GOALS

<b>Supportive Environment Framework</b>	By June, 2023, practices related to Personal Attention & Support will improve 7%, from 78 to 85, as measured by positive NYC School Survey responses, resulting in improved Collaborative & Trusting Relationships.
<b>College, Career &amp; Civic Readiness (CCCR)</b>	By June, 2023, College, Career & Civic Readiness (CCCR) for All Students will Increase 10%, from 48% to 58%, as measured by the number of full IB/Diploma Program candidates .
<b>Graduation Rate</b>	By June, 2023, Graduation Rate for All Students will Increase 8%, from 92% to 100%, as measured by New Visions Data Tracker Portal.
<b>High School ELA</b>	By June, 2023, High School ELA for Hispanic will Increase .7, from 76.3 to 77, as measured by NYS ELA Regents Exam Results.
<b>High School Math</b>	By June, 2023, High School Math for Hispanic will Increase .8, from 32.2 to 33, as measured by NYS Math Regents Exams.
<b>Chronic Absenteeism for All Students</b>	By June, 2023, Chronic Absenteeism for All Students will Increase We anticipate a 6% increase in schoolwide student daily attendance.%, from 89% to 91%, as measured by Schoolwide Daily Attendance Data.
<b>Middle School ELA</b>	<p>By June, 2023, Middle School ELA for Hispanic will Increase .8, from 124.2 to 125, as measured by a minimum performance exceeding the Level 4 MIP goal.</p> <p>By June, 2023, Middle School ELA for Black will Increase .8, from 129.2 to 130, as measured by a minimum performance exceeding the Level 4 MIP goal.</p>
<b>Middle School Math</b>	<p>By June, 2023, Middle School Math for Hispanic will Increase .2, from 75.8 to 76, as measured by 21-22 School Math MIP.</p> <p>By June, 2023, Elementary/Middle School Math for Black will Increase .3, from 91.7 to 92, as measured by 2020-21 State-level Math Subgroup MIP.</p>


